Yosoya OHASHI died at Lemon Creek, B. C., on May 7, 1945. He is survived by his widow, Masu, file #12495; one son, Hikosaku, Internee file #1041; and one daughter, Shizue, file #12475, all of whom returned to Japan on the S. S. Gen. Meigs on June 17, 1946.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none are revealed on the file. The only claim appearing on this file is for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 to cover funeral expenses paid by the B. C. Security Commission for his burial. They were advised by this office on July 25, 1945, that no funds were available from which to pay this claim.
