

No chattels were declared by either of the above Japanese persons but according to a letter on file dated December 17, 1942 from Mr. Fisher of the B. C. Security Commission, fifteen or more cases of tools were stored in Johnston's Storage either under the name of YABACAR Auto Works, I. TANAKA or K. TANAKA. Mr. Fisher stated that Slocan advised these tools were needed urgently for use in repairing their trucks.

The Custodian advised the B. C. Security Commission under date of January 18, 1943 that they had no objection to these tools being shipped to Slocan provided (1) a release was obtained from Mr. Yoshio TANAKA, (2) as neither of the above Japanese declared tools we were not sure of the rightful owner, therefore pending decision as to ownership we wished the tools to be released to the Slocan Supervisor to be held under his control for Japanese use at Slocan.

On January 29, 1943 (File 12452) the B. C. Security Commission stated their Supervisor at Slocan accepted the conditions laid down by the Custodian, that these tools be held under his control for the use of the Japanese, and they attached Custodian Release form signed by Yoshio Tanaka releasing the above-mentioned tools for use of the B. C. Security Commission Garage. The B.C. Security Commission also advised that Yoshio Tanaka claimed that "these tools belong to his brother and himself on a fifty-fifty basis". A note on our letter of February 10, 1943 on file 12452 states shipment of 15 boxes of garage tools was made on January 30th.

Agreement to use of tools by B.C. Security Commission garage at Slocan was given by Koryo Tanaka in a letter on his file dated March 4, 1943.

No further reference to these tools is made on either of the above files.

A review of these files does not reveal any other chattels belonging to the above Japanese person in the protected area.
