The above signed a declaration to the effect that he had no property of any kind on August 24, 1942 and was evacuated on May 16, 1942.

CHATELS: A Carton marked with his name was moved from 391 Powell Street, where he formerly resided, to 154 West 5th. Ave. From information supplied by Mr. Wills, it would appear that the place of storage was ransacked and no trace of the Carton can be found.

This file reveals no ^{other} property of any kind, nor does it reveal any liabilities.

A check of the files of persons who had left goods at the above address, has been made from a list supplied by Mr. Wills. This list comprised items found on the chattels when they were removed to 154 West 5th Avenue, in June 1945.

A carter and oils were sold by auction for Yoshitaro HARAGUCHI and a trunk belonging to MATSUHITA, Shige, Int. 1013 shipped to him. Nothing else was to be accounted for and Mr. Wills advises that the chattels were thoroughly examined in the Victory Rooms and again at 154 West 5th.

There is nothing in the names of any of the former tenants stored at 544 East Cordova Street.
