Dear Madam:-

The B. C. Security Commission have passed on to us a letter written by your brother complaining about the way your radio has been handled. We are not answering this letter direct as we see that you and your brother are both living at the same address and what we are now writing will explain everything.

The B. C. Security Commission tell us that in October 1943 they requested you to sign application forms for your radio but that they heard nothing further from you until August 1944. Meantime, however, the radio had been sold in accordance with the Government's policy of liquidation.

As we have now received the R.C.M.P. receipt handed to you at the time the radio was surrendered we are sending you the funds received therefrom being \$45.00, less auctioneer's fee and advertising \$6.11, or a net sum of \$38.89.

No other correspondence was received from this girl, but on the 23rd of this month, the enclosed arrived at our office.

The foregoing is for your information and guidance, in the event that you decide to reply to Suefuji.

We also enclose herewith the R.C.M.P. receipt which you will require as proof of ownership.
