

GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Tozo FUJIMOTO

This Japanese person was evacuated on March 29th, 1942, and made his declaration afterwards on a "J" Card. His statement of January 17th, 1944, declared that he had no property whatsoever in the Restricted Area of British Columbia.

A refund of \$4.73 was received on his behalf from the Provincial Collector, representing 15 wage deductions for first six months of 1941. This was placed to his credit. The file does not reveal any other assets belonging to him.

A number of claims, representing debts owing by FUJIMOTO were filed with the Custodian as per Claim Summary. His creditors were advised that the Custodian had no funds belonging to him and that nothing further could be done to assist them.

~~In view of the extent of his debts, therefore, his credit balance is being omitted.~~ *Repat*

No property interests other than the above are found on this file.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.
