This Japanese person made his declaration on a "J" card under date of January 17, 1944.

His declaration states that he had no property in any Protected Area of British Columbia but, on the reverse side of his card, he states that he had an equity in a 1941 Chevrolet car and that some effects were in 828 Royal Avenue, New Westminster.

CHATELS:

Nothing further is revealed on this file in regard to personal effects at 828 Royal Avenue and it is assumed that he made his own disposition of them.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

The declarant owned a 1941 Chevrolet Car on which he stated he had paid \$610.46. The car, however, was re-possessed under lien agreement by Duak Nichol Motors Ltd. and sold by them for \$1104.50. Unpaid balance of \$982.03; repairs, \$54.69; licence and commission, \$115.75; storage, \$60.00; were charged against the selling price, leaving a loss of \$107.97 to the dealers.

A damage claim was settled by Vancouver Adjustment Bureau and the amount of \$25.00 was forwarded by them, on January 3, 1944. This was credited to Kaju KAWAGUCHI.

I am in receipt of your letter of the 31st ultimo, and in reply beg to advise you that according to our records, 1941 Chevrolet Sedan, Engine #3736029, was originally registered and licensed on September 27, 1941, in the name of K. Kawaguchi of 8927 Hudson St., Vancouver, B.C. under 1941 licence #B-936.

On ~~March 12, 1942~~, this motor-vehicle was transferred out of the name of K. Kawaguchi to Dueck-Nicoll Motors Ltd., 1305 W. Broadway, Vancouver, B.C. On December 7, 1942, it was transferred from Dueck-Nicoll Motors Ltd. to Blue Cabs Ltd., 329 Columbia Ave., Vancouver, B.C., in whose name, this motor-vehicle is still registered. 1943 licence #59-645 was issued for this motor-vehicle.
