Dear Sir:-We are in receipt of a letter from the Credit Bureau of Vancouver, to whom you have apparently written regarding the claim of the Vancouver General Hospital for \$10.95, about which we wrote you sometime ago. In your letter to the Bureau you apparently referred to some tailoring equi ment which you claimed was left by you at 578 Powell St. Vancouver. In reviewing your file it is noted that you declared on the 25th of August 1942 as follows:-"I have no property of any kind whatsoever in any Protected Area of British Columbia". However, the declaration of your wife dated September 3rd, 1942 mentioned certain chattels as at 578 Powell St. A report regarding these will be forwarded by the Department handling her file.
