We have written on various occasions to Mr. and Mrs. Genjiro Hori, who are now at Sardon, B. C. and previously lived at 1646 West 2nd Avenue, Vancouver, regarding a claim against them by the B. C. Telephone Company for Exchange Service from October 1st to November 20th, 1942 at \$2.50 per month, the total claim being \$5.15, in connection with telephone number Bay, 4861-1 at 1646 W. 2nd Avenue.
