GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Masaichi TANEDA - Reg. No. 04211

The above Japanese declared a quantity of chattels being left on the property of his father-in-law at Haney. Our fieldmen inventoried same on the 10th June, 1942. Details of our inventory were sent to the Japanese for confirmation, but no reply was received.

When our fieldmen were liquidating the chattels from the property, all chattels were grouped and sold under the father-in-law's name, and if any adjustment is necessary between them they will have to make it between themselves.

The Japanese also declared a number of War Savings Certificates and a Sun Life Insurance policy, but these were not brought under control by the Custodian.

A refund of his Provincial Income Tax amounting to \$4.34 and a refund of his B.C. Electric Security Deposit, amounting to \$3.00, were received at this office and were credited to his account here.

This file reveals no other assets or liabilities.
