



This file reveals that SHIMISU owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mr. Kanekichi SHIMISU declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file. These were sold at auction for the net sum of \$67.45 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian. Full details are given on chattel schedule and chattel summary on file.

From his credit we are paying an account of 90¢ owing to the City Scavenging Dept. leaving his credit \$66.55. SHIMISU was repatriated on the S.S. General Maigs on Aug. 2/46 but was not given his balance with the Custodian as the files had not then been fully checked and we were not sure that all goods credited to him were really his.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

CHattel SUMMARY

RE: Kenkichi SHIMISU, Reg. No. 02507

On August 25, 1942, Mr. SHIMISU signed a yellow "No property" card stating he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B.C. However on Sept. 22/42 he signed a J.P. form declaring chattels as shown on the Chattel Schedule, at 232 Powell St. where he had formerly operated a restaurant. The rooms above this were operated as a rooming house by Taju SHIMIZU, #110935, and the property was owned by Kiichi OKURA, Int. 675.

Goods at this address were inventoried by our agent, Mr. H.D. Campbell on Oct. 3/42 as shown on Chattel Schedule and allowed to remain on these premises. However when the Custodian took an inventory on June 14/43 it will be noted that the list differs from the original inventory taken by Campbell. At any rate all the chattels declared by SHIMISU are accounted for, with the exception of one table, as noted on Schedule. The only article sold and not inventoried is one Japanese fiddle, but such an instrument was not declared by SHIMISU nor by OKURA, so it has been left to the credit of SHIMISU. The chattels were sold for the net sum of \$67.45 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian.

Mr. SHIMISU was repatriated to Japan on the S.S. General Meigs on Aug. 2/46, but as the files had not been completely summarized and the ownership of certain chattels was in doubt, the funds were not released to him and still remain to his credit on our books.
