GENERAL SUMMARY

Kinoji KAWAHARA, Deceased

Reg. No. 14352

Kinoji KAWAHARA died at Hastings Park on September 12, 1942. According to his declaration, he was a widower and has one son and one daughter in Japan.

The deceased declared no assets and no liabilities to the Custodian but, at the time of his death, he had the sum of \$87.00 on his person and a cheap watch and chain. The B. C. Security Commission retained the sum of \$77.50 to cover funeral expenses of the deceased and the balance of funds, amounting to \$9.50, was turned over to this office along with the watch, chain, wallet and money belt belonging to the deceased. These effects were sold at auction for a net amount of \$1.58. A trunk, suitcase and damage bag belonging to the deceased were found in Custodian storage. The contents of this luggage was found to be valueless, consisting of worn and moth-eaten clothing. The containers were sold at auction for a net amount of \$7.78.

Funds to the credit of the deceased in this office, amounting to \$18.86, were transferred to an esony account No. 1624, in the name of "The Heirs of Kinoji Kawahara, deceased. In Japan"

No assets and no liabilities, other than those mentioned above, appear on this file.


MEMORANDUM.

Re: Estate of Kinoji KAWAHARA, Deceased.

To: Mrs. Cleaver.

Regarding the credit balance of \$18.86 in the account of the above Japanese person, deceased, it appears that Kinoji Kawahara declared that he had no wife, but two living children, Takaji (son) age 42 living in Japan, and Chikano (Mrs. Konishi) (daughter) age 44 also living in Japan. The R.C.M.P. report indicates that this man's wife Fusa pre-deceased her husband.

Since our file indicates no other property belonging to this dead man, and that the Department of Labour funeral bill has been paid, I would suggest that the money be left where it is for the present indicating on your card and your list that this is a matter to receive attention later.


