



Mrs. Ueno declared to the Custodian on the 25th of August, 1942 that she is indebted to Dr. Shimotakahara in the sum of \$50.00 and also to Mrs. F. Sameshima, c/o Mr. Hough July, R.R. 1, Barons, Alberta in the sum of \$80.00.

She states that she proposes to pay these from monies receivable from the sale of rooming house business located at 358 Powell Street, Vancouver. She states further that Mr. Robinson bought the business for \$510.00.

These debts are probably both chargeable against the husband's property.

Would you kindly advise Mr. McAllister of the Evacuee Section, who is looking after claims, that you are taking care of these debts, if such is the case.
