GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: HORI, Ito (Mrs. Shotaro), widow  
Reg. No. 97778

Mrs. HORI, housewife, lived in the small house at the rear of 1661 West 2nd Ave., renting from Fusajiro OBAYASHI, File 11749. She signed a declaration to the Custodian on August 31, 1942, and was evacuated on October 28, 1942.

She declared ownership of 1 kitchen cupboard, 6 chairs, 1 closet, 3 tables, 4 beds, 1 box of chinaware and 2 carpets, all to be left at 1661 West 2nd. Memo, dated October 13, 1942 states, "On October 11th Mrs. Hori was still in possession. She has sold the majority of her chattels, and if there is anything left requiring our protection at the time of her evacuation she will advise us." This file reveals no further information regarding her furniture and effects, but on file 12296 Tose OBAYASHI (Mrs. Fusajiro), a memo made March 16, /43 says "Mr. Harstone of the Western City Co., who are our agents for this property (1661 West 2nd Ave.) stated that the small house was quite empty with no furniture, etc., in same." It would seem that Mrs. HORI disposed of her household effects prior to evacuation.

Also on August 31, 1942, Mrs. HORI declared ownership of one \$5.00 War Saving Certificate in the name of son, Toshio. This remained in her own possession.

August 31, 1942, Mrs. HORI declared ownership of a Life Insurance Policy, Prudential Insurance Co. This policy was kept in her own possession. Information from the Prudential Insurance Co., on file XI 466, Tadao HORI, shows she had two policies, 108371899 for \$135.00 and 108371892 for 90.00,
