





Re: Kiyoshi KUNIHIRO, Reg. 15529

Kiyoshi Kunihiro signed a yellow card on May 5th, 1942 declaring no property, and he was evacuated on the same date.

He signed a J. P. on October 23rd, 1942 declaring that he owned a balloon tire bicycle and an R. C. A. Victor standard wave radio. Both these he stated, were in his own possession at Kaslo.

Prior to our memo of December 22nd, 1942 he asked for the shipment of two cases of records left at 321 Boyne Street, New Westminster. These were declared however, by his brother Oto KUNIHIRO, File 1690 and they were shipped on December 9th, 1942 by Belyea and Company.
