This file reveals that Miss IGISHIRO owned no real property in any protected area of B. C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

Miss IGISHIRO made her declaration to the Custodian on Sept. 3/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 23/42. She signed a yellow "No property" card stating that she owned no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area. However she wrote on Dec. 15/42 and asked to have her radio and camera shipped to her. She was advised that it was not in accordance with Government regulations to make shipment of these articles. She asked again on Apr. 22/46 for shipment of these articles and we advised her that the radio had been sold for the net sum of \$29.31 and this sum credited to her account with the Custodian. The camera was shipped to her on May 13/46.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
