


Dear Sirs:

Replying to your letter of 25th instant, the chattels of Risaburo Morimoto were sold and the proceeds credited to his account in the net sum of \$36.06.

At the time that Mr. & Mrs. Morimoto returned to Japan, they were issued with a draft of \$200.00 each by the Government of the Dominion of Canada, and all moneys collected by the Custodian had to be turned over to the Treasury Department to be applied against these drafts.

The Insurance was in the joint names of Risaburo Morimoto and Mrs. Toraye Morimoto and the Crown Life Insurance Co. Ltd. paid to the Custodian \$353.04. This amount together with the above mentioned \$36.06 totalling \$389.10 was sent to the Treasury Department and applied on the drafts.
