Dear Madam:

We wrote you on May 25th to Slocan, B. C., but our letter was returned and was re-mailed to you at your present address on June 13th. We do not know whether the letter has reached you or not. In case it has not reached you, we are writing again.

We understand that the J. W. Kelly Piano Company are holding your Victor radio, on which there is a balance owing of \$19.60, plus carrying charges of 50 cents a month. This would amount to approximately \$35.00.

If you wish to have this radio returned, you should get in touch with the J. W. Kelly Piano Company, and arrange for payment of the outstanding balance and the storage costs and shipping charges.

In case you do not wish to have the radio returned, or are not in a position to arrange for payment of the various charges against the radio, we would suggest that it would be to your advantage to have the radio sold as soon as possible, before the charges on the machine equal the value of the radio.

If you decide to have the radio sold, please send us the receipt which you received from the J. W. Kelly Piano Company, so that we may claim the radio. We will then arrange for sale by auction and will forward to you the balance remaining after the various charges have been paid.

Dear Madam:-

We see that the J. W. Kelly Piano Company are holding your Victor radio on which there is a balance owing of \$19.60 plus carrying charges of 50¢ a month since October 4th, 1942, or approximately an extra \$15.00. As you are aware, radios are not permitted in Interior Housing Settlements and we suggest that rather than continuing to run up charges against your radio, it be sold at auction, the account owing paid, and the balance credited to your account. Alternatively, you could send us funds (\$34.60) to pay off the balance and carrying charges to date and the radio can remain where it is.
