PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS: The above registered on Sept. 3/42 and was evacuated on Oct. 15/42.

In her declaration to the Custodian she stated that her agent, Richards, Ackroyd & Gall Ltd., were arranging for the sale of her rooming house business and furniture. In a report received from this firm on Oct. 15, 1942, they indicated the difficulty of renting this rooming house of 24 bedrooms owing to lack of sanitary fixtures and the deplorable condition of the premises. They supplied an inventory of the furniture in the rooming house showing an appraised value of \$65.45. On Dec. 12/42 they advised us that they had an offer for the sale of this furniture at \$65.00. We advised Mrs. KITAMURA of this offer, at the same time pointing out the difficulty of looking after premises in this locality of the town, as so many places in this vicinity had been entered and goods stolen. We wrote to her three times regarding this matter but received no reply. We then advised Richards, Ackroyd & Gall Ltd. to accept the offer. From the sale price of \$65.00 they deducted appraisal fee of \$7.50 and their commission of \$3.25, leaving a balance of \$54.25 which they sent to this office to be credited to the account of Mrs. KITAMURA. Previous to the sale of this furniture insurance was placed on same and the premium in the amount of \$2.68 was deducted from funds standing to the credit of Mrs. KITAMURA. This insurance was discontinued when the chattels were sold.

SHARE

INVESTMENT:

On Nov. 3/42 we received a cheque in the sum of \$9.85 from the Prudential Trust Co. Ltd., Calgary, being royalty on Major Oil Investment of which Mrs. KITAMURA was a shareholder. A further cheque for \$1.00 was received on this from the Prudential Trust Co. Ltd. on Nov. 18/42 and credited to the account of Mrs. KITAMURA. A cheque for the total amount of \$10.85, less the \$2.68 paid for insurance on furniture, was remitted to Mrs. KITAMURA on Dec. 10/42. A further sum of \$.73 from the Prudential Trust Co. Ltd. was credited in error to another KITAMURA, but has now been transferred back to the account of Mrs. Misako KITAMURA and is still in her account. Her Major Oil Investment Certificate was sent to Mrs. KITAMURA on June 17/46. Her account is also credited with \$35.00 from the account of her husband. At the request of her husband, an Internee, the sum of \$35.00 was sent to Mrs. KITAMURA every month and this amount deducted from funds standing to the credit of the Internee with this office. The last remittance of Aug. 27/46, instead of being sent to Mrs. KITAMURA, was apparently just transferred from the account of her husband to her account.

LIFE

INSURANCE:

She declared an insurance policy with the Prudential Insurance Co. in the sum of \$1000.00, the beneficiaries being her daughter Teruko and her son, Hiroshi. A number of insurance policies were found in the name of the KITAMURA family. These are dealt with on the file of the husband, Int. 991.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Misako KITAMURA states on her JP Declaration, September 3/42, the following: "The agent Richard, Akroyd & Gall Ltd., 614 W. Pender St. is arranging to sell the business and furniture. If the furniture is not sold a list will be brought in later, and the key will be given to the agent".

Richards, Akroyd & Gall, Ltd., state in their report of October 15th, 1942: "The furniture is delapidated, but the bedding appears to be clean but very old and torn".

On October 20th, 1942, they supplied us with an Inventory & Appraisal of chattels at 351 Powell St., amounting to \$65.45. On December 12th, 1942, they wrote stating receipt of an offer to purchase the goods and chattels at the appraised price of \$65.00. Mrs. Kitamura was written to on Dec. 17/42 and Jan. 4/43, re this offer but no reply was received. In our letter of Jan. 7/43, we informed her that unless we heard from her by Jan. 15/43, we would authorize Messrs. Richards, Akroyd & Gall, Ltd., to dispose of the chattels for \$65.00. No reply was received and on Jan. 15/43 we wrote Messrs. Richards, Akroyd & Gall, Ltd., giving them authority to accept the offer of \$65.00. From the sale price of \$65.00 they deducted the appraisal fees of \$7.50 and their commission of \$3.25, sending us a cheque for the balance of \$54.25, which was credited to Mrs. Kitamura's account.



In answering your letter of November 5th we would advise that we are unable to give you M. Kitamura's full name. This party's certificate is registered in a manner similar to that as shown on the cheque. We believe however, that this royalty interest is held by Mrs. M. Kitamura in which case the "M." could stand for either a masculine or feminine name.
