Thank you very much for your letter dated October 12th and for your courtesy in returning to us, duly completed, the "JP" registration forms requested in our letter to you dated September 8th.

In so far as your War Savings Certificates are concerned we wish to call your attention to the fact that these certificates are not in the hands of the Custodian and have not been in the hands of the Custodian. On September 8th we were informed by the Office of the Registrar, War Savings Certificates, Ottawa, that you had applied for proceeds of War Savings Certificates having a face value of \$100.00. The Registrar asked whether or not the Custodian's office had any objections. We replied to the Office of the Registrar by mail on September 8th and informed them that the Custodian had no objection whatsoever to your receiving proceeds of the certificates in question.

If, by the time you receive this letter, you have not received proceeds, we suggest that you communicate direct with the Office of the Registrar of War Savings Certificates, 350 King Edward Avenue, Ottawa.

We had informed the Registrar of War Savings Certificates that this office had no objection to this man receiving proceeds of his Certificates, and we informed SEKITA of this, and advised him to write direct to the Office of the Registrar of War Savings Certificates. Nothing further appears on file in regard to this.

The Mutual Life Insurance Co. reported Policy #536772, on the life of this man. This did not come under the control of this office.
