GENERAL SUMMARY

This man was evacuated on March 18, 1942. He has not at any time signed a declaration to the Custodian in regard to his property.

In October, 1942, Genkuro HARUSE, File 2183, informed us that a trunk belonging to TAKEMOTO was stored in a shed at the rear of 557 East Cordova Street, together with the effects of Mr. HARUSE. A memorandum on file under date of December 15, 1942, indicates that the trunk was found stored in this shed by Custodian agents, but it would appear that the impression given by the memorandum is incorrect. There is nothing on record to show that an inventory was ever made of the contents of this shed. The chattels stored in the shed were removed to 992 Powell Street in October, 1944. At that time this trunk could not be found.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
