

In reviewing our files in connection with Mr. Shohachi Omoto and his wife Mrs. Shika Omoto, our attention has been drawn to the fact that we do not appear to have on file a copy of the Bulk Sales Act declaration signed by Mrs. Omoto, although in your letter to us dated May 7th, 1942, you make mention of the General Securities Limited claim of \$54.20 and the Hazelwood Creamery Limited claim of \$160.00 as being the only two liabilities admitted by Mrs. Omoto.

Pursely in order that our records may be complete, will you please be good enough to let us have a copy of the Declaration made by Mrs. Omoto under the Bulk Sales Act.

Subsequent to the sale made by your client, we have learned of a claim against the Omotos of \$98.40 said to be owing to the Neon Products of Western Canada Limited and a Mr. Yoshitaro Yamashita has also declared to us that the Omotos are indebted to him to the extent of \$500.00.


In reply to your letter of the 3rd inst. I now enclose
