This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on September 9, 1942, the day before his evacuation.

In this declaration he reported a bank account with the Bank of Montreal, Main & Hastings, Acct. No. 2110, \$200.00, and a Mutual Life Insurance Company for \$1000.00, beneficiary his father, policy in his own possession. Neither of these items came under the control of the Custodian.

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police reported to this office that this man had surrendered a radio and record-player on March 10, 1942. These articles were sold for the net sum of \$58.80, which has been credited to the account of Torao KOTANI. At request of Torao KOTANI this sum was transferred to Mr. Toshio KOTANI File 11965, May 20, 1945. *gm*

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police reported that this man surrendered a camera. This camera was at 604 Cordova Street on March 15, 1946, and will be returned to the owner if he wishes. *Camera mailed to KOTANI May 20/46. Jm*

Your file with this office reveals that in your declaration to the Custodian on September 9, 1942, you reported a bank account and a life insurance policy. Neither of these items came under the control of this office.

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police reported to this office a radio and record-player which, they stated, had been surrendered by Toshio KOTANI Registration No. 06952, 306 Abbott Street, Vancouver. These have been dealt with in your file, but it would appear that these articles were surrendered by you on behalf of Toshio KOTANI, Reg. No. 00428, who formerly lived at 201 Abbott Street, Vancouver, B. C., as we have received from Mrs. Toshio KOTANI the receipt given at the time the radio and record-player were surrendered. These articles have been sold and the proceeds are in Custodian account. Before remitting the proceeds to Mr. & Mrs. Toshio KOTANI, we would like to know that you have no interest in the radio and record-player.
