As she may be leaving in the near future, we shall be glad if you will report further on this case, advising what arrangements Mrs. Nakamura is making for the disposal of her business, or if she is not selling same, what she proposes to do about her equipment, etc.

In our letter of the 29th of May we asked you to please confirm that the pressing machine is fully paid for--apparently there was some question as to this, and as we do not appear to have received a reply from you on this point, we shall be glad if you will look into this.
