The would point out that it was agreed with the husband, pred Seture Highikama, that \$75.00 should be sent at the time (and of August 1943) to his wife, and \$50.00 per month thereafter, except that for October the amount would be increased to \$75.00 to take sere of sinter clothing. \$75.00 was sent at the end of August and \$50.00 at the end of September, and a cheque for \$75.00 will be forwarded through your office in a day or so. Subsequently \$50.00 per month will be remitted to Hrs. Hightkawa.

Sound mention in passing that in early September \$50.00 me forwarded to Mr. Bisbikawa at his urgent request, and this separated deploted the funds on hand.

The credit balance in Mr. Hishikawa's account after deducting the above \$75.00 is \$21.00. October rents amounting to \$75.00 mill not be received by us from the Agents until may mid-November.

With Christmas and New Year holidays, buying little needs for the children have left my funds very low and 1 am very anxious to receive my January allowance of \$50.00. With the children catching colds during the flu epidemic, extra medicinal expenses had to be incurred.

It would be very appreciated if you can forward at an early date my allowance for January and at the same time issue cheque for February, as it is now nearing the end of the month of January.

Reference to memorandum to file of November 23rd (201) shows the following position here:

"In order to suit the convenience of the tenant we moved the chattels from suite two to suite three. Where they had better remain as long as possible.

Mar. D. A. Smith reports the chattels of an inferior quality, mostly home-made articles, and if moved to Custodian Storage would cause difficulties. This was a rooming house and the Japanese failed to mark their chattels with their names, and identification is impossible.

P.S. We have now received a letter from Mr. Chikao Tamamoto, file 12357, saying that he left his stuff at 2001 Foxon Street: No details are given and Mr. Chikao Tamamoto is being advised that in the absence of further particulars, we shall have to credit everything to his brother's account.
