Proof of Claim against persons of the Japanese race.

I, Walter Barrington Piers residing at Haney in the Province of British Columbia, make oath and say as follows:-

1. That I am the Manager of the Haney, B. C. Branch of Bank of Montreal and am duly authorized to make this affidavit.
2. That Chiyokichi Omura of R.R.1, Port Hammond, B. C., a person of the Japanese race, died on or about 20th March 1940.
3. That the said Chiyokichi Omura is indebted to the Bank of Montreal in the amount of \$229.00 (Two hundred and Twenty-Nine dollars).
4. That the said debt is the balance of an advance of \$750.00 made on 1st March 1940, under the Home Improvement Plan, repayable \$20.84 on the first day of each month, until 1st March 1943.
5. That Shogo Omura, a son of the deceased, has been making the monthly payments and has at this date a credit balance of \$245.93 on deposit at Bank of Montreal, Haney, B. C. and has instructed the Bank to debit his account with the monthly instalments as they fall due.
6. That repayment of the debt is guaranteed by the Dominion Government in the event of default by the borrower.
