The goods at 347 R.Cordeve were stored in two upstairs looked rooms and a looked supposed downstairs, which had been reserved for this purpose when the house was leased by Mrs. Rive MAKAMURA acting as agent for her son, Gensaburo NAKAMURA. The keys were in the care of the tenant.

Prior to the sale of the house in ABril, 1944, none of the owners of the chattels stored in these premises gave this office any detailed information about these chattels. There we were some that goods belonging to a Japanese were in this house and communicated with him asking for details he implied (in each case) that he was satisfied with the storage and did not give us details of his chattels. In the majority of cases, we were not aware, until after the goods were moved affilhe identity of the owners.

This and the absence of identification on the various articles led to confusion.

In December, 1945 copies of the auction sheets covering most of the articles moved from 347 B. Cordova were sent to Genzaburo NALAMURA, who obtained the signatures of Siye MAKAMURA, Shigeo FURUKAWA, Kana WATAWABE (wife of Sumiye) and Shigetaro KAGAWA to an authorization in regard to the distribution of the proceeds of these mustions. Distribution was made as authorized.

It is not clear shy Orito Tambell was not consulted in regard to this distribution. The records show that he, on may 22, 1944, requested shipment of 2 Wicker I runks and one wooden but stored at 347 ElCordova. One of the trunks(kori) was shipped to him in response to this request. One trunk and what appears to be the salesble contents were sold becauser 7,1945. The wooden but which he said contained Chinaware is not accounted for, unless this was identified as the property of either Shigetaro Kadawa or Mrs. Rive Makadwa at the time of sale, in which case it would be among the goods sold and listed on the muction sheets sent to Gensaburo Makadwa in December, 1945, as reported abore. A mirror and picture were sold on May 2,1944 and the proceeds credited to Orito Tambou. On May 22,1944, he reported mirrors and other things in one of his firmly.

The information given on the back of Mr.Bell's inquiry of January 5,1946, in encour to that inquiry, is not correct. The goods said for Files 9337 and 2182 were not removed from 347 E.Cordova, according to our records.






