- On April 21, 1942 - S. Takahasi signed for these effects, but on May 8, 1943, Mr. Spain who called at 228 Main St. reported that the tenant, Mr. Bergquist stated that he had purchased these chattels for \$50.00. The wife of Kenjiro Kambara, signed a "J" card on Sept. 10, 1942. She was evacuated Sept. 24, 1942. Probably Mrs. Kambara disposed of these goods before her evacuation.

War Savings Certificate - \$5.00

\$4.04 redemption value of this certificate received April 6, 1943. These funds were transferred to account of R. Tagashira, File 5129, to apply on debt of \$1,000.00 which Kambara reported owing.

Neither this file nor the file of Mrs. Kambara reveal any other assets or other liabilities.
