
According to this man's file he did not register with the Custodian and the R.C.M.P. sheet in front of the file states that Joichi UYENAKA died on May 23, 1942.



I am giving you for your files the claim of M Kato against the above named Uyenaka, who had his office in the Dominion Building in this City. On the first day of February A. D. 1927 Kato recovered judgment against Uyenaka for the sum of \$913. 85 with costs to be taxed.

At one time I obtained an order for \$20. 00 a month but only one payment was made. so with interest at the rate of 5% the Judgment would be increased by a large amount. ✓

If there is anything in Uyenake's Estate I would be pleased to take this matter up with you in more detail.
