This file reveals that Mrs. OGINO owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. OGINO made her declaration to the Custodian on Sept. 17/42 and was evacuated on Oct. 1/42. She declared no chattels. No chattels are declared by Mr. OGINO.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: Mrs. OGINO declared the sum of \$209.00 owing to her by Fuji Chop Suey Co., 314 Powell St. She stated this money had been owing since 1941. We wrote to P. S. Ross & Sons on Oct. 7/42 regarding this claim as they were handling the affairs of the Fuji Chop Suey Co. They advised that the books of the company showed this amount owing to Mrs. OGINO. On Jan. 29/45 the account of Mrs. OGINO was credited with the sum of \$146.30 being a distribution of 70% of the amount owing by Fuji Chop Suey Ltd.

I telephone P. S. Ross & Sons today to ask if Fuji Chop Suey Ltd. had been liquidated and if there would be a further distribution on claims against the company and they advised that there might be a very small distribution when the company is finally liquidated.

SHARES: Mrs. OGINO declared 66 shares at \$100.00 in the MAIKAWA LTD. I have today telephoned P. S. Ross & Sons regarding this company and they advise that this company is not yet liquidated but they do not think there will be any return to the shareholders of this company.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: Mrs. OGINO declared three \$10.00 War Savings Certificates in the name of her son Saburo, in her own possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE: Although Mrs. OGINO did not declare any insurance, in her letter of Feb. 8/45 she requests us to find out from the Sun Life Insurance Co. what is owing on premiums on her policy and pay this out of the money standing to her credit with the Custodian. We contacted the Sun Life Co. and were advised that amount owing in premiums and interest on Policy No. 2253878 in the name of Mrs. OGINO amounted to \$120.40. A Cheque for this amount was remitted to the Sun Life Co. on Feb. 12/45 and a copy of this letter together with a letter advising her of our action and giving her the balance in her account, was sent to Mrs. OGINO.

Copies of correspondence regarding the affairs of MAIKAWA LTD. are on file, but these have nothing to do with Mrs. OGINO personally.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
