


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

In your registration with the Custodian, you declared personal property.

With a purpose of offering protection, our representative visited 361 Powell Street and there discovered what was apparently property of your good self. We have packed and stored in a Custodian safe warehouse everything that could be found and these have been packed and stored as follows:

- 2 Wash Tubs
- 5 Boxes sundries
- 2 Cross cut saws.

We assume that you have no other personal property in the restricted area of British Columbia.

According to Police Report this man's address is 391 Powell Street. The address given on his declaration dated 20th October 1942, has been changed from Slocan City to 381 (by you) Powell Street. A list dated August 4, 1942 which has been amended to read Toyozo Takahashi, Registration No. 00345 ?, address - 381 Powell Street, indicates certain chattels. Your letter of November 14, 1942 states that the Custodian's representative visited 381 Powell Street. On June 2, 1943 Mr. Wills signed a list indicating one carton taken from 391 Powell Street, Victory Rooms, and transfer of same to 156 W. 5th Ave. Your final letter dated May 21, 1946, states that this Japanese declared lamps, saws and utensils at 381 Powell Street. *Is the address of this man 391 or 381 Powell St.*

Were Japanese goods taken from 381 Powell Street, or has this man a relative who might be confused with him? According to copy of letter on file written by Miss Matheson relative to insurance policies, this man has a brother Tsuseburo Takahashi. Would you please put a memo on file clarifying this situation?
