This file reveals that Mr. NAKAGAWA owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. Previous to his evacuation he did carry \$1000.00 fire insurance on his tailoring equipment at 400 E. Hastings St.

CHATELS:

Both Mr. and Mrs. NAKAGAWA declared chattels so these have been combined on one Chattel Schedule as shown on file. Goods were shipped as shown on the Schedule. Certain chattels were left with a Mrs. Miller who occupied the premises at 633 Powell St. after Mr. and Mrs. NAKAGAWA left the Coast. Mrs. Miller stated these had been given to her by the NAKAGAWA's in return for taking care of their dog. We wrote to Mrs. NAKAGAWA asking her to confirm this but she did not reply to our letter. It would therefore appear that she had made this arrangement with Mrs. Miller.

A few items appear to be "not found" as shown on the Chattel Schedule. However neither Mr. or Mrs. NAKAGAWA have complained of any shortages in the shipments received by them, so it would seem that these articles had been included in the shipments or had been incorrectly declared.

MONEYS
RECEIVABLE:

In July, 1945, the account of Koichi NAKAGAWA was credited with the sum of \$2.46, representing a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Mrs. Miller, the tenant at 633 Powell St. after the evacuation of Mr. and Mrs. NAKAGAWA, came into this office and showed us a letter from Mrs. NAKAGAWA agreeing that in return for caring for Mrs. NAKAGAWA's dog, Mrs. Miller was to be allowed to have the following articles:

1 chest of drawers
1 kitchen cabinet
2 easy chairs
oilcloth in front room
1 leather davenport couch
1 table.

Mrs. NAKAGAWA never replied to our letter of Oct. 22/42 asking for confirmation of this arrangement. We may assume therefore that this arrangement was satisfactory to Mrs. NAKAGAWA. The only chattels not accounted for would appear to be the following:

1 counter
2 tables
electric heater
4 chairs
1 bed
gramophone and records
1 bureau.

However as neither Mr. or Mrs. NAKAGAWA have complained about any shortages in the shipments, it would seem that all items of any value have reached them safely.
