On September 17th, 1942 a claim for \$25.00 was lodged against the above Japanese person by the Retail Credit Grantors Bureau Limited on behalf of Dr. J. A. Montgosery. The Custodian submitted the above claim to Takashims on October 5th, 1942 and he replied on October 12th stating be did not one Dr. Montgosery any money and had no connection with the above claim. We referred Takashima's reply to the Retail Credit Grantors Bureau Limited and after further investigation on their part they advised the Custodian under date of January 23, 1943 to close his file on the matter as they were unable to obtain sufficient information from their client.

This claim was therefore dropped and Yoshichika Tukashina was so advised by the Custodian on January 29th, 1943.

Do other claims were lodged on this file against the above Japanese person.

Chattels:

No chattels were declared by the above Japanese person but auction information reveals that 8 boxes of ceremonial toys were removed from "Granville Street" in the name of "Y. Takashima". As Mr. Takashima's former address was 978 Granville Street, Vancouver, and our records do not reveal any other "Y. Takashima" under a Granville Street address it is presumed that these ceremonial toys were the property of the above Japanese and we are therefore releasing the small credit of \$1.05 obtained from their sale to Yoshichika Takashima.

No other effects are revealed on this file or that of Yoshichika Takashima's wife - file 10648.

Specified Articles:

No Specified Articles belonging to the above Japanese person are revealed on this file.

Life Insurance:

On his JP form dated October 12th, 1942 the above Japanese declared a \$2500.00 Empire Home Benefit Association policy in his name. No action regarding this insurance has been taken by the Custodian.

(Yoshichika Takashima also declared insurance on behalf of his wife and son and reference is made on this file to the Cash Surrender of Mrs. Takashima's insurance, a cheque being sent to her in July 1945. This is dealt with more fully on her file.)

BONDS, etc.

Mr. Takashima declared on behalf of his son \$75.00 worth of War Savings Stamps. No action regarding these Stamps has been taken by the Custodian.



In December, 1939, the above party was introduced to us by

Eoh Takahashi of the Nippen Imperting Company, Toronto, and we issued a guarantee bend
to the Camdian Pacific Railway Company, Freight Department, to enable the above to
obtain from the Railway Company a shipment of electric goods from Tokio, value \$120,
the understanding being that as soon as the original bill of lading was received it
would be returned to the Railway Company and our bond handed to us. As collateral for
this transaction, the amount of \$120, was deposted in a savings account and the present belance is \$111,40. Although we have not yet received the return of the Bank's
bond, we are asked by this party to release the funds to him, but before considering
the matter we would like you to contact the Custodian of Enemy Property and ask him
if he has any interest in the account.
