We wrote to Mr. IWATA regarding this claim but he did not reply to our letters. We advised Mrs. NISHIMURA of this in our letter of April 26/44, giving her the address of Mr. IWATA so that she could contact him direct regarding payment of the claim.

Dr. UCHIDA \$ 12.00

This account was withdrawn by Dr. UCHIDA.

David Neon Ltd. filed a claim against K. IWATA and K. KUBA, operating under the name of Mode-O-Day, in the sum of \$116.64. We were advised by the Income Tax Department that the main shareholder in this company was Mrs. Haruko IWATA, wife of Kinichi IWATA. However it would not appear that Mr. IWATA had any shares in this company, so this claim should not be against him but against the company. Mrs. IWATA sold out this business before leaving the coast so it would seem that there is nothing we can now do about collecting this account.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.



Thank you very much for your letter dated June 16th indicating that the Hole-O-Day Dress Ltd. is indebted to you to the extent of \$2,157.27 for unpaid income taxes for 1941.

In reviewing our file in connection with the Hole-O-Day Dress Ltd. we find that we were advised on January 19, 1942, by Clarence Darling, R.C., 56-57 Commerce Building, 642 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, that his client, Mr. Sidney Liverant, of 650 Granville Street, Vancouver, was purchasing the stock-in-trade and business of Hole-O-Day Dress Ltd., of 413 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, together with the unexpired term of the lease of the premises. Mr. Clarence Darling also indicated that Mr. John Sutherland was solicitor for the vendor.

In reply, Mr. G. W. McPherson, Authorized Deputy of the Secretary of State and/or Custodian, advised Mr. Clarence Darling on January 19, 1942 that the Custodian voiced no objection to the sale mentioned above.

Mr. Kinichi Iwata, Police Registration No. 00915 declared to us on December 7, 1942 that his address was P. O. Box 263 Salson Ave, B. C. and that his previous occupation was that of a dress manufacturer. Mr. Iwata also indicated that he had left in storage with Messrs. Bowman's Storage Ltd., 827 Powell Street, Vancouver, certain plotting, sponging and pressing machinery together with a buckle machine, 2 button machines and some cases of button and buckle molds, all of which he had insured for a total of \$3,000.00 against loss by fire.

Our records also indicate that on October 2, 1942 Mr. Joe Wimbere telephoned this office and stated that Mr. Kinichi Iwata had saved certain garment manufacturing equipment to Salson Ave.

In view of the circumstances detailed above, we would suggest to your attorney as to the nature of any action you may desire the Custodian to take on your behalf in connection with your claim against the Home-Only Trust Ltd.

Present balance of a little over \$600.00 to Herbie Isaacs have reduced her credit balance with the Custodian to the amount of \$100.00. The Custodian credited Herbie Isaacs' account with the Custodian accordingly and payments were subsequently by this office 600 West Hastings Street. The Custodian credited Herbie Isaacs' account was sold to Lily Clark who was represented by Mr. J. Green Grant, Solicitor, adjustments. The property, which was also known as 366 West Gordon Street, Company Ltd. The real estate was sold for \$2,500.00 cash subject to certain and later through the assistance of Messrs. Macmillan, Macmillan & Co. 325 Bond Street, Vancouver, for the sale of the real estate sold and where 196. Mrs. Isaacs negotiated through the Wilson Insurance Agency, Ltd., Isaacs was the owner of real estate known as Lots 11 and 12, Block 26, D.
