According to the present white occupant operating the Dry Cleaning establishment, he pays Mr. Hicks, the owner of the building, \$65.00 per month for rent of building and hire of Dry Cleaning Machinery.

He admits that the machinery belonged to Mrs. OKAZAKI and was purchased by her cost about \$3400, since which date there has been considerable wear and tear and depreciation which would reduce this figure considerably. The boiler was worn out and discarded being beyond repair.

It would appear that Mr. Hicks is holding the machinery as security for a mortgage amounting to \$1100.
