GENERAL SUMMARY

Takashi HAMAKAWA died at St. Joseph's Oriental Hospital in Vancouver on November 28, 1945, at the age of 25 years. He was single and is survived by his mother, Masu HAMAKAWA, file #13077.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian but, according to a R. C. M. P. Report on file, a Signal Transmitting Key, valued at 50¢, was taken from him by the R.C.M.P. This key cannot be found and it is presumed that it was among articles stolen.

The only claim appearing on this file is for the sum of \$7601.00 for hospitalization of the deceased in the Provincial T. B. Unit. This covers 2667 days at \$3.00 per day, less \$400.00 paid on account by Mrs. Masu HAMAKAWA, mother of the deceased. This claim also appears on the file of Masu HAMAKAWA, #13077, as Takashi HAMAKAWA was under 21 years of age for a portion of that time. The Collector of Institutional Revenue has been apprised of the state of Mrs. Hamakawa's finances.

No assets and no liabilities, other than those mentioned above, appear on this file.
