Tour letter of November 26th with reference to a hospital bill against the above person has been received. This office has had no record of a due Kawaguchi, but letters were written regarding this claim to Suzuko Kawaguchi who formerly lived at Alert Bay, but no reply was received from her.

According to the Department of Labour records, Eusuko Kawaguchi, born on May 25, 1921 appears to be the daughter of Tsuruse Kawaguchi whose wife is Suyone Kawaguchi. Neither Suzuko nor Suyone Kawaguchi have assets with the Custodian.
