GENERAL SUMMARY

August 2, 1946.

Re: Chotaro TATEMACHI, Reg. No. 03116

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on October 1, 1942 in which he reported that he owned no property of any kind.

However, the R.C.M.P. handed to this office a General Electric radio surrendered by this man. This was sold and the net proceeds of \$12.04 were credited to the account of this man.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

The Provincial Board of Health filed a claim for \$63.90 against this man. This was settled in full by the B. C. Security Commission payment of \$60.90.

Dr. Lee Smith filed a claim for \$110.00 against this man. This was settled by Dr. Uchida according to a letter written by Dr. Uchida on December 5, 1944, and no further action has been taken by this office.

This file reveals no other liabilities of any kind.

That I owned a General Electric radio, Serial No. 31056-C and that I delivered this radio to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police on the 10th day of March, 1942, and obtained a receipt therefor.

That I have made a most diligent search for the said receipt. I have not found the same and the sole reason for the non-production of the receipt is that it has been lost or accidentally destroyed.

That I, Chotaro TATEMACHI, the owner, am therefore now entitled to the proceeds of the sale of my radio.
