This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on October 2, 1942, at Hastings Park Bureau. He had been evacuated originally on March 30, 1942, but must have later returned to Vancouver.

In his declaration he reported only his two life policies with the Prudential Life Insurance Company. Neither of these items were brought under the control of the Custodian.

A Packard car, registered in the name of Yoshiro ISHIDA in 1942, is dealt with in the Memorandum filed directly behind this summary. No funds were paid in to Custodian Account in connection with the sale of this car.

The sum of \$2.27, received as refund of one per cent wage deductions for 1941, was remitted to Yoshiro ISHIDA on October 30, 1943.

No other property of any kind is revealed by this file.

MOTOR-VEHICLE MEMORANDUM

April 23, 1947

Re: Yoshiro ISHIDA, Reg. No.06022

This man was the registered owner of a 1936 Packard 120 motor-car, which was stored at Dueck-Nicol Motor Company garage on June 16, 1942.

On June 16, 1942, the B. C. Security Commission informed the Custodian that the Rev. Yutaka OGURA, who was proceeding to Grand Forks and would require a car in the performance of his duties, was purchasing this vehicle from Yoshiro ISHIDA. The Custodian, therefore, authorized the release of this car to Yoshiro ISHIDA in letter of June 16, 1942, addressed to Dueck-Nicol Motor Co. On that date, also, Yoshiro ISHIDA signed a Release and Discharge of claims and demands in connection with this vehicle. Nothing further appears on file in regard to this car. No payment in connection with the sale of this car was received by the Custodian on behalf of Yoshiro ISHIDA. It would appear that the transaction between Mr. OGURA and Mr. ISHIDA was negotiated directly by themselves, and that the car was released as authorized.

Know all men by these presents that Yoshiro Ishida, of 3014 Wall Street, in the City of Vancouver, in the Province of British Columbia, for value received, doth hereby remise, release and forever discharge the Custodian, appointed pursuant to regulations established by P.C. 3959 as amended, his deputies, servants, agents and representatives, of and from any and all causes of action, claims and demands whatsoever which the said Yoshiro Ishida as principal or as agent, bailee or representative or otherwise howsoever may or might have for or by reason of any seizure, custody, possession, control, holding or keeping by the Custodian or by any one acting on his behalf of the motor vehicle, 1936 Packard 120,

And the said Yoshiro Ishida doth covenant and agree with the Custodian to defend, indemnify and save harmless the Custodian and his deputies, servants, agents and representatives from and against any and all claims, demands, damages, penalties, loss, costs and/or expenses which may hereafter be made or charged against the Custodian or against any of his deputies, servants, agents or representatives or which the Custodian or any of the said deputies, servants, agents or representatives may bear, suffer or sustain by reason or on account of any seizure, custody, possession, control, holding or keeping of said motor vehicle by the Custodian.
