GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 13081

Rinichi MORI, Deceased

Reg. No. 11580

Rinichi MORI died in St. Joseph's Oriental Hospital in Vancouver on April 25, 1943. The deceased, in his Custodian Declaration, stated that he had been married but was divorced in Japan in 1934. He had no children. The only living relative shown on his R. C. M. P. Report is his mother, Han MORI, in Japan.

The only asset declared by MORI was twelve \$5.00 War Savings Certificates which remained in his possession. As these were not found at the time of his death, it is presumed that they were cashed prior to his demise.

A small row-boat found at Ocean Falls and sold by the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for a net amount of \$4.95, was identified as belonging to the deceased and the proceeds credited to his account. An Evinrude engine, removed from a boat at Ocean Falls, and turned over to the Custodian, was identified as belonging to Rinichi MORI and the net proceeds from its sale amounting to \$14.94, were credited to his account, giving him a total credit of \$19.89.

A claim was filed against the deceased by the Provincial Board of Health for the sum of \$153.00. This was settled by the B. C. Security Commission for the sum of \$147.90, which was accepted as payment in full. A claim for \$77.50 was filed by the B. C. Security Commission against the estate of the deceased to cover his funeral expenses.

A cheque for the sum of \$19.89, being to total credit balance of the deceased in this office, was forwarded to the B. C. Security Commission on March 9, 1945, to apply against their claim for funeral expenses.

I have just referred transfer requisitions to me which I have signed transferring a small sum of money to the account of the above Japanese.

This man died in April, 1943 in St. Joseph's Hospital, Vancouver, but signed a declaration October 1, 1942.

I note a burial claim on file from the B. C. Security Commission in the sum of \$77.50, as well as a claim from the Provincial Board of Health which apparently was paid by the B. C. Security Commission.

Would you kindly prepare a memorandum giving particulars of this man's death, next-of-kin, assets and liabilities, and transfer the file to Mr. Wright, who I believe, will authorize payment of funeral expenses without referring the estate to the Official Administrator.
