Following my conversation with clerk in your office a day or so ago, I herewith submit the following particulars relative to the above named Company.

This company was incorporated August 27th 1925, with a capitalization of \$20,000.00 divided into 200 shares of a par value of \$100.00 each.

The company then proceeded to engage in the logging and lumber business but suspended operations in or about the year 1933 or 1934 and ever since then the company has been wholly inoperative and the only active steps which it has taken has been to file with the registrar of companies at Victoria the annual report which is required under the Companies act.

The last report was filed on the 11th day of June, 1941 and covers the period from the 30th day of December, 1939 to 30th day of December 1940.

*interested* The company has a total of 15 shares outstanding, being held as follows:- Toyose Matsuyama-1share (Matsuyama formerly quite prominent here in business circles moved to Japan about 1 year ago, where presumably he still is.), Kuyze Uyenaka-1 share. He was formerly a merchant at Woodfiber, B. C. but is now employed in the pulp plant there. Osame Uyenaka, 325 west 5th Avenue, Vancouver B. C. is the wife of the next mentioned party and holds 12 shares of the company. Joichi Uyenaka, of 207 West Hastings Street, holds 1 share and is a lumberman.
