In the matter of the Bankruptcy of Shinichi Kawada and Higoro Hiraga, trading as Kawada Box Co., Vancouver, B.C.

The Company made a voluntary assignment in Bankruptcy on Jan. 16/42 and at the statutory meeting of Creditors The Canadian Credit Men's Trust Association Ltd. were appointed Trustee (File 13110).

After due process the Custodian received Statement of Receipts and disbursements in the above connection from the Trustee, dated Aug. 11, 1943 showing a total amount available for distribution of \$4,093.82. This statement showed a first and final dividend of 17 1/2% in respect to ordinary Creditors which dividend amounted to \$2,096.70. Of this amount the Custodian received \$1,402.94 as per our official receipt No. 6239 dated September 3rd, 1943. This was for distribution to Japanese creditors by the Custodian according to list contained in Trustee's letter dated August 27th, 1943 received.

Practically all details of the liquidation are carried on file 10521 as per instructions, undated, on file 13110.

We confirm our telephone conversation with you yesterday in regard to the affairs of the above Company which was owned by a partnership consisting of S. Kawade and E. Hirega. The Company made a voluntary assignment in Bankruptcy on January 16th, 1942, and at the statutory meeting of creditors we were appointed trustee.

For your information we enclose copy of the bankruptcy notice, list of creditors and statement of affairs as at January 9th, 1942.

Subsequently the assets of the box factory were sold to the Fraser Box Company, a Chinese firm, for \$3,500.00, and the purchase price has been received by us.

Part of the equipment consisted of -

- 1 Log haul
- 1 Swing wood frame cut-off saw
- 1 Conveyor

which were in the warehouse of the Vancouver Mill Machinery Company. It now appears the latter company hold a Vendors' lien over those items of equipment and in order to make delivery of same to the purchasers it is necessary for us to pay the amount of the lien, \$345.00.

The validity of the lien has been investigated by the Solicitors to the Estate and we have been advised same must be recognized.

we are making payment so that we may complete delivery to the
purchasers.
