Dear Sirs:- RE: Storage of Chattels. Property of Japanese Subjects.

At the present time, we have but one lot, belonging to Mrs. K. Iwashita, Edmonton, Alta. This lot originally consisted of 58 pieces received into storage on October 13th, 1942.
