

I, Takaichi UMEZUKI of 2854 McGill St., Vancouver, B.C. do solemnly declare:

1. That I owned a radio, General Electric mantel radio # 637 (305051) and have personal knowledge of the facts herein declared.
2. That I had in my possession and control at 2854 McGill St., a radio, General Electric mantel radio Serial No. 637 (305051).
3. On the 9th day of March, 1942, I delivered the said radio to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and obtained a receipt therefor.
4. That I have made a most diligent search for the said receipt in all repositories where such receipt might be. I have not found the same and I verily believe that the said receipt has been lost beyond recovery or destroyed.
5. That I have not in any way dealt with the said receipt or papers relating to the said radio and have not pledged or hypothecated the same or lodged the receipt with any person, firm or corporation as security.
6. That the sole reason for the non- production of the receipt is that it has been lost or accidentally destroyed.
7. That I have been informed that my radio has been sold for the sum of \$28.27 net.
8. That I, Takaichi UMEZUKI, the owner, am therefore now entitled to the proceeds of such sale, amounting to \$28.27 net.

AND I make this solemn declaration, conscientiously believing it to be true and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath and by virtue of the Canada Evidence Act.

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 4th instant regarding claims filed in this office against you.

Nos. 1-4 inclusive are filed against you by the creditors named, and we are reporting to them what you say and shall await their replies.

Nos. 5-9 inclusive were declared by you as indebtedness of yours in your registration of October 1942. These five accounts do not appear to have been lodged against you. You say that you have made arrangements with them whereby these debts will be cleared with them personally. We shall therefore leave it to you and them to arrange settlement.

Re: Radio

You say that the R.C.M.P. receipt must have been misplaced by you. It is noted that the receipt was sent to this office in your letter of January 5th, 1943 and was returned to you in our letter of the 19th Jan., 1943. It may be that you will find it attached to our letter of that date, if you will look through the letters received by you. However in case you do not locate it, we have prepared a declaration which we are enclosing herewith for you to sign where indicated, and complete before a Commissioner. When you return the R.C.M.P. receipt or this declaration properly completed, we shall release the funds derived from this sale to your open account on our books.

Re: Funds

Referring to the closing paragraph of your letter of the 4th instant we may say we shall be unable to forward the funds on hand to your credit until such time as the claims, especially the first four, have been adjusted to the satisfaction of the creditors. The matter of radio must also be arranged.

Let us therefore have your prompt attention and reply.
