In reply to our letter regarding these claims SOGA advised that the claim of the B. C. Purchasers' Co-operative Assn. had been settled in full on March 6/42. (See letter May 12/44).

In his letter of May 12/44 he agreed that the claim of NAKAMICHI against him was correct, but stated that he could not pay same at that time. Although he told us in this letter that we could use funds in his account and any sums collected on accounts receivable on the file of his wife, to pay this claim, we did not transfer his credit to the account of NAKAMICHI. Instead we advised NAKAMICHI in our letter of May 23/44 that we could do nothing more about collecting this account and gave him the address of SOGA so that he could contact him direct regarding payment of the claim.

There are no other claims filed against either SOGA or his wife.

Dear Sir and Madam:

In reviewing your files and registration forms we find the following claims registered against Mr. Soga:

1. Seiichiro NAKAMICHI \$200.00)
2. B. C. Purchasers' Co-operative Association 121.14)

We notified Mr. Soga of these on February 23rd of last year, but our files do not show any response from him, hence we are at a loss to know if these claims are regarded as correct or otherwise. This is the information we require, and if they are correct we wish to know what the prospects are for payment, in whole or in part, at this time.

It is noted that our letter of February 23rd, 1943 listed the Canadian Food Distributors as a creditor for \$214.66 due to an error in extracting. This is now shown as a debtor for that amount, and a dividend is shown below as having been credited to Mr. Soga's account. This is represented as the final dividend.
