
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

LIABILITIES:

A Claim for \$109.50(Balance) by Vancouver General Hospital against Taki NAKANISHI is lodged with the Custodian. She, her husband, and her son, Eiichi, who guaranteed the account, have been written to a number of times but has not paid anything on account through this office. The account is admitted, as also the Guarantee by the son, Letter Nov. 13, 1942. After such correspondence, we finally advised the Hospital per letter August 30th, 1945 that we were closing these files in respect to their claim.

No other claims against or indebtedness of Taki NAKANISHI are revealed on the file.

We are closing our files in this connection. The files indicate an unusual amount of correspondence relating to this claim. Our last letter was written to the Department of Labour, Japanese Division on the 15th March last. In this letter we included the father, mother and son, hoping that we might be successful. We received a reply from that Department dated June 7th last from which we quote as follows:-

"The father of this man is in receipt of an Old Age Pension in the amount of \$25.00 a month. Eiichi receives \$45.00 a month in wages, and is not in good health. He states that they are incapable of meeting the claims since he is unwell and physically unfit for heavy work, and that his mother is an invalid, causing additional expenses. He also refuses to make any promises regarding future settlement."

The three are still at Teshae B.C. and their respective names are:- Eiichi NAKANISHI #00046(son) Tami NAKANISHI #00051(mother) Isichi NAKANISHI #00054(father).
