Tokubei KASHIWAGI died in Vancouver, B. C. on September 24, 1942. According to information received from the R. C. M. P., he was divorced and his wife had returned to Japan. He had no living relatives.

KASHIWAGI did not complete a Custodian Declaration and, therefore, no information concerning his assets is available.

The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim against the estate of Tokubei KASHIWAGI for the sum of \$52.50 to cover the cost of the funeral of the deceased. They were advised by this office that the deceased had no assets from which to pay their claim.
