The Internee's request of 15th instant was referred to the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, from whom we have received the following reply:

"We would not at this time be willing to recommend that the credit balance of \$994.01 in the name of the above be forwarded to his daughter Shizuko, #01124, who is residing in Montreal. If Mrs. Inamoto should become destitute she would no doubt be appealing to us for financial assistance. Therefore, we would appreciate if you would hold her husband's funds in his own name."

Under the circumstances we cannot comply with the Internee's request.

We are also advised that the Internee's daughter, Seiko #03190, owes the Department of Labour \$207.00 for hospitalization and medical costs. May we please be advised if he is willing to have these charges paid from his account.
