Miyoka Yasuda died at New Denver, B. C. on August 15, 1947. She is survived by her father Tsuneo, File 4139, and her mother, Akino, File 8510, both of whom have now been repatriated to Japan.


The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and there is no evidence of any on file.

A claim was filed against the deceased and her father, Tsuneo Yasuda, for the sum of \$2100.00, by the Provincial Board of Health to cover maintenance of the deceased in St. Joseph's Oriental Hospital for 700 days from April 30, 1941 to March 30, 1943. The sum of \$107.59 was paid on this claim on February 12, 1947, from the account of Tsuneo Yasuda.

A claim for the sum of \$80.00 to cover funeral expenses was filed by the Department of Labour on September 9, 1947. They were advised that the deceased had no assets from which their claim might be paid.

No assets and no liabilities, other than those mentioned above, appear on this file.
