PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Yoshikichi MINATO

Reg. No. 06965.

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on the 10 September 1942. In this declaration he reported a quantity of household and personal effects. These chattels had previously been reported by his wife and had been administered in her file number 4546. He reported 3 War Saving Certificates with a total value of \$40.00. These were in the hands of the Custodian at the time of his declaration. On October 22, 1942, the Custodian sent by registered mail to the Supervisor at Tashme, the 3 War Saving Certificates belonging to MINATO.

On May 26, a declaration was made out for this man but was not signed by him. In this declaration he stated that \$200.00 was due him from a relative whose name he did not give. Nothing further appears on file in connection with this.

In this unsigned declaration are listed the following securities: Deep Bay Logging Co. shares \$1000.00, \$150.00 Victory Bond and \$40.00 in War Saving Certificates.

3 bank accounts are listed on the unsigned declaration all with the Japan & Canada Trust Co., \$500.00 in his own account, \$130.00 in his wife's account and \$120.00 in the account of his son. The list of depositors of the Japan & Canada Trust Savings Co. as at December 31, 1942, does not show the name MINATO among the depositors at that date. It would appear that all the funds had been withdrawn from this account prior to December 31, 1942.

In regard to the chattels which are dealt with in file 4546, the greater part of the chattels declared were shipped to the owners. The saleable articles remaining were sold for the net sum of \$33.08. This sum has been credited to the account of Masano MINATO, file 4546, the wife of Yoshikichi MINATO.
