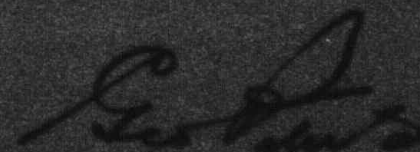
LIABILITY SUMMARY

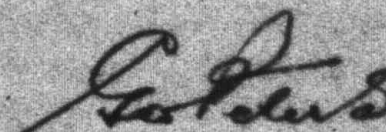
